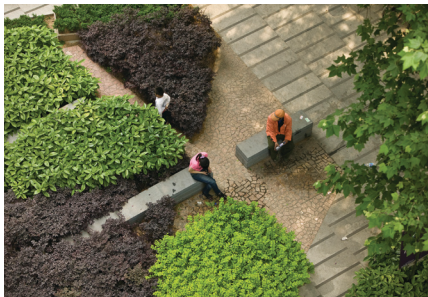


Nanjing Greenland International Commercial Center



Nanjing Greenland International Commercial Center is an urban high-rise site, that encompasses existing parks and the adjacent historic Drum Tower to the South. The 450-meter main tower and its concentric rings of mixed trees and linear water features is the focus of the overall site. Sidewalks are widened to include an urban parterre garden consisting of hedges, colorful perennial flowers, and seating that increase the commercial vibrancy of the street and allow easy and convenient pedestrian movement between the ground floor retail stores and the adjacent streets.
