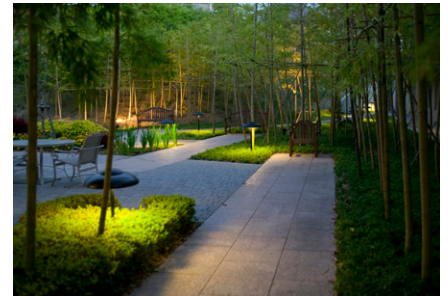


Sun City Takatsuki



SWA provided full landscape architectural services for this project, one of several similar projects SWA has done with Half Century More. Located in a bedroom community midway between Osaka and Kyoto, this 220-bed facility has both Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing levels of care. The landscape design, complementing the modernist architecture, is organic and fluid with meandering paths traversing various gardens on the south side of the building connecting feature terraces located at each end of the building spine. In addition the building entry lobby is made more inviting by the use of a light well at the south side.
