



Jeffrey Open Space Trail Art Program



Timeline panels are located along the main trail of the three mile Jeffrey Open Space Trail, commemorating significant events in Irvine history. This timeline interprets the natural history and Native Americans of the region to establishment of the Spanish Ranchos and evolution of the Irvine Ranch to the development of the City itself. Other art objects include historic images of fruit crate labels and timbers salvaged from the Valencia packing house celebrating the agricultural industry of the area.
