The renovation of the historic Green Library and its landscape, closed after the Loma Prieta earthquake in 1989, allowed the redefinition of the classical ideas of the library in relation to the historic Main Quad. Apart from the overall historic importance of the project, the design included redefining features such as the great lawn and fountain, key elements that define the overall character of the setting, and enhancing the efficiency of circulation by the new layouts of pedestrian, bike and service access.
