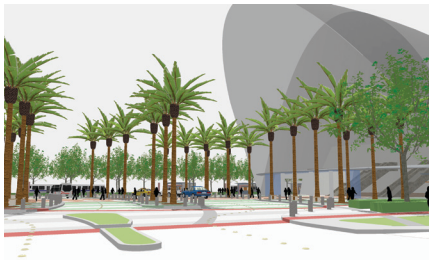




Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC)



SWA provided urban design and landscape architectural services for the 16-acre Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC), a significant, LEED Platinum-designed transit facility. ARTIC forms a seamless gateway from Anaheim to all of Orange County, spurring economic growth and community redevelopment throughout the region. The landscape design establishes a unique and identifiable image for the ARTIC Mixed-Use District by complementing the site's iconic architecture with a strong streetscape identity. A large central plaza, designed to evoke the feel of a European square, integrates passenger drop-off areas, a central pedestrian zone, and a forecourt for the terminal building. Artwork is also incorporated into the overall plaza design adding aesthetic diversity. Date
